Australian Information Warfare:
Beyond the Defence Strategic Review

Welcome

On behalf of AOC Australia, welcome to Convention 23. This year's Convention theme – "Australian Information Warfare: Beyond the Defence Strategic Review" – was selected in recognition of Australia's evolving geopolitical environment and government's recent and ongoing response to that evolution.

The challenge posed by the paired influence of complex Indo-Pacific dynamics and military application of advanced technologies is driving a necessary and urgent revitalisation of domestic capability priorities and strategic partnerships.

The Defence Strategic Review identified the information environment and its associated disciplines – cyber, electronic warfare, and information operations – as critical future-focussed, joint-enabling

capabilities, but failed to elaborate on the objectives that will bring these capabilities to fruition.

The other major initiatives of AUKUS Pillar II and the Advanced Strategic Capabilities Accelerator are also in the early phases of scoping their engagement with the information warfare community, and so the pathway to delivery of comprehensive information warfare capability remains unclear.

This Convention aims to narrow that gap. To thrive in this dynamic global security paradigm, it is imperative that we comprehend the information ecosystem, understand the opportunities it offers and the vulnerabilities it presents, and identify how best to exploit information technologies to deliver competitive advantage to our warfighters.

Presenting this week are some of Australia's key stakeholders from end-user organisations. Sitting in this room are Australia's most qualified and experienced information warfare professionals, representing investment from government, Defence, industry, and academia. Invited speakers and attendees from partner nations have travelled to participate, in recognition of Australia's important contribution to combined capability.

Together, and through this Convention, we will seek to broaden the discussion around information warfare capability need, identify the associated challenges and opportunities, and discuss the ways in which we can move forward as a community to guide fit-for-purpose capability outcomes for Defence.

Importantly, we will also seek to understand how we best grow and support the workforce that underpins that capability.

This Convention is an unrivalled opportunity to engage with Australia's professional information warfare community and I urge you share your experience here with your networks. Thank you for your support of this event and of AOC Australia; we look forward to engaging with you over the coming days.
